The Hendricks House Group is licensed by the State of New Jersey as a residential treatment center staffed by licensed and certified counselors who are supervised by a Masters-level clinical director. Our facilities provide a caring, highly-structured environment where people recovering from addiction can regain their self-worth and develop skills necessary to make a sober, successful transition back to work, family, and society.

Over 200 clients complete the program each year. Clients put in a full day's work and return to their house for an evening meal prepared in their own kitchen and served in the community dining room. Dinner is followed by group or individual therapy sessions, 12-step meetings or recreation on the premises.

We maintain a strong 12-step orientation and require all residents to complete the first four steps while in treatment, to attend meetings and to embrace 12-step principals and philosophy.

This persistent and effective regimen helps assure that clients return to their home communities clean, sober and responsible parents and citizens.

2022 Distinguished Service Award Honoree

Robert (Bob) Buono is a lifelong Vineland resident who has distinguished himself as a businessman and as a citizen champion of an endless array of community activities and projects. A graduate of Sacred Heart High School, Bob received an Associate's Degree in the first graduating class of the then Cumberland County College. Since then he has contributed to the growth of our community and has had a profound effect on the lives of many of its inhabitants.

Here are just a few of the ways Bob has influenced countless people in our area: he served on the St. Isidore Parish Council for 10 years; he ran the Cumberland County CYO Basketball Program for 15 years: he was an original board member of the Vineland Soccer Association; he was active in the VBA basketball league in Vineland, and he was on the Inspira Hospital Golf Committee for two years. The list of charities he has supported is long, including the Inspira Foundation, the Vineland Fire Department, Special Olympics, Cumberland County College, St. Augustine Prep, St. Mary School, and the Ronald McDonald House.

In addition to many years of supporting community activities, Bob has excelled as an area businessman. He tells the story that his business life started at the age of nine when he and a neighbor friend had a twenty-block snow cone route. He recounts how their goal was to make \$7.00 a day...and whether they did or not, it didn't matter because they persevered. Later as an adult he started Carlo's Pizza and fondly recalls how they struggled at first to actually make the pizzas round. As he persevered, the enterprise became successful and led to state contracts. After 11 years, along with his partners, he created Eatem Foods and acquired a New Jersey Economic Development Authority loan to build a plant.

With family members Bob also owns the Eastlyn Golf Course and founded the Greenview Inn in Vineland. In addition to his outward look toward the community, Bob recognizes that everything he accomplished was made possible by the love and support of his wife Roe and his family. His family now includes their three sons and daughters-in-law as well as nine beautiful grandchildren.

A true community leader with a strong family, Bob understands the value of connections to the health and well-being of everyone in a community. When told of his selection for the Hendricks House award he responded simply: "Thank you for allowing me to become one of you."
